

Vote for R. H. MILLER For County School Superintendent



I am listing below plans and resolutions made by the Board of Education of Floyd County relative to new building for the Floyd County Schools:

1. The Board of Education passed a resolution to maintain Johnson High School, May 31, 1951.
2. The Board of Education passed a resolution to maintain Glenwood as an elementary center, February 25, 1952.
3. The Board of Education has had an inspection made of the Coosa block building by structural experts and by the Georgia Safety Fire Commission. No immediate danger was disclosed, and the Board has authorized structural experts to recommend the repairs necessary.
4. The Board of Education has made application to the Federal Government under Federal Law for War Impact Areas for Federal aid for building. Floyd County will share in this program if Congress makes a sufficient appropriation.
5. The Board of Education is making an application to be presented to the Georgia School House Building Authority and the State Board of Education. This application will be presented when these authorities indicate they are ready for Floyd County projects. Building plans for Alto Park, Armuchee, Coosa, the Colored Schools, Glenwood, and additions at other school centers are being completed.

The Board must indicate in this application which schools are most urgently needed. Alto Park, Glenwood and the Colored Schools have been listed as ones needed most.

THE ABOVE ITEMS ARE BOARD OF EDUCATION ACTIONS, NOT POLITICAL PROMISES and are in the realm of the duties of the Board of Education.

The State Reviewing Committee recommended several consolidations, but the final decisions of these matters are left to the County Board of Education.

Teachers' salaries certainly need to be raised, but supplements will not be the answer. A real salary increase is the only sound method.

MY PLATFORM, published over a month ago, was a proposal of ACTION—actions that a County School Superintendent is supposed to do, not a platform of promises—promises that are based on decisions that must be made by the Board of Education.

MY PLATFORM may be summed up in three words: EFFICIENCY, ECONOMY, AND COOPERATION.
