SCHOOL NUTRITION CHARGE POLICY

PRIMARY/ELEMENTARY BREAKFAST

1. *Breakfast may not be charged.* This includes Primary, Elementary, Middle, and High School.

PRIMARY/ELEMENTARY LUNCH

1. Students are allowed a *maximum* of *three* lunch charges.
2. Student meal account charge letters are given to homeroom teachers two or more times per week.
3. Parents will be notified after the second charge that his/her child will need to bring money for meals. Parent notification will either be a charge letter as mentioned in procedure #2, or via email, the school system all-call, or a combination of these.
4. If, after the third lunch charge, the student does not bring money he/she may have the opportunity to call the parent/guardian to bring money to the school. If the student does not receive money before coming through the lunch line he or she will be given an alternate meal consisting of a sandwich, milk, and fruit.

MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL BREAKFAST

1. *Breakfast may not be charged*

MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL LUNCH

1. *ONE lunch* charge is the *maximum* number of allowable charges for middle and high school students.
2. Student meal account charge letters are given to homeroom teachers two or more times per week.
3. Parents will be notified after the first charge that his/her child will need to bring money for meals. Parent notification will either be a charge letter as mentioned in procedure #2, or via email, the school system all-call, or a combination of these.
4. If, after the first charge, the student does not bring money he or she will be given an alternate meal consisting of a sandwich, milk, and fruit.

EXTRA ITEMS/ALA CARTE

There will be absolutely no charges allowed for the following items:

1. Ala Carte Items such as snacks, ala carte meals at the high school level, extra milk or juice, or side items off the main line.
2. If a student owes charges, he/she may not be allowed to purchase ala carte items until the charges are paid.
3. If a student brings a meal from home and wishes to get a milk or juice from the school cafeteria, the student must either have cash in hand or money in his/her meal account. *This includes students who receive Free and Reduced price meals.*

ADULT CHARGES

Adult charges are not allowed. This includes faculty, staff, and visitors.
